## THE POWER OF FRIENDSHIP: A STORY OF ALPHA PHI, SPORTS AND MUD

Mud matted my hair. It oozed into my eyes, my ears and between my toes. I was drenched.

I thought life couldn't get better than this.

Then the ball was in my hands. I ran as fast as I could through that sea of mud. I scored! We won.

Oh, life did get better.

Playing in the Mud Bowl – a University of Michigan Homecoming tradition – is a cherished Alpha Phi memory. Mud Bowl, a Sigma Alpha Epsilon and Phi Delta Theta-sponsored mud football competition, first brought together two important parts of my life: Alpha Phi and sports.

Since I was a little girl, sports have been essential to my happiness. I even made them part of my profession – sports medicine. I'm lucky to do what I love.

When I joined Alpha Phi, I thought, "I'm joining the best sorority on campus. Great!" It seemed simple. Now I look back on years of Alpha Phi moments – memories that didn't end after only four years – and I know Alpha Phi is for a lifetime.

In college, my sisters brought me Tab® (is this stuff still around?) when I needed to stay awake for all-night study sessions. When I went to medical school, they listened as I debated for hours about specialty choices. When my 30th birthday came and I was away from home, they traveled across the country to surprise me with a huge reunion.

Last year, the same women celebrated with me when my team – the Detroit Red Wings – won the Stanley Cup. (I'm one of the team's orthopedic surgeons.) Twenty-six years after Mud Bowl, I'm still cheering with my Alpha Phi sisters.

I've had other pinnacles in my life – particularly being the only orthopedic surgeon sent to oversee the National Hockey League at the Salt Lake Olympics last year. But I'll never forget diving into the end zone at Michigan and screaming with my sisters.

That same experience of support in college has to be available for women today. No matter how sophisticated and educated we've become, no matter how many professional fields now welcome women, there's nothing like the feeling that comes from knowing your sorority encourages you, helps you learn new things and urges you to develop the old.

That's why I'm a member of the Foundation's *Power of 100*\*. My gifts support programs that help women gain confidence and support through lifelong Alpha Phi friendships.

And I hope that one fall day, each of these women will have her moment in the mud.

## University of Northern Colorado's Joan Clinefelter Named Professor of the Year

Dr. Joan Clinefelter is a history teacher.

Try to tell her that.

"The image of a history professor is hardly a flattering one: a boring figure who lacks social skills and drones on from behind a podium while reading from lecture notes," she says.

Dr. Clinefelter doesn't hide behind a podium. Instead, she makes barricades out of furniture, tells jokes and even bursts into British soldiers' songs.

"I'm willing to look ridiculous in order to cross the gap between student and professor," Dr. Clinefelter says.

She even threw out a Western Civilization textbook. Students instead read novels written during the era of study.

"I've read many texts that I never thought would apply to history. But after discussion and analysis in Dr. Clinefelter's classes, events in history change from black and white into color," says **Gretchen Sausville** ( $\Delta\Gamma$ -Northern Colorado), the chapter member who

nominated Dr. Clinefelter.

Learning doesn't stop with history lessons in Clinefelter's classroom. She teaches students how to conduct research, pose historical questions and write research papers.

"Although they often don't notice, I'm also preparing students to become interested, well-spoken, literate, critical thinkers who are valued by the 'real world,'" Dr. Clinefelter says.

Her students do notice – perhaps one of the reasons Dr. Clinefelter is Alpha Phi Foundation's 2002 Professor of the Year.

"She has given me insights and skills I will always carry with me. She taught me to think critically and speak my mind," Gretchen says. "Many students have one teacher who will forever leave a mark on his or her life. For me, that teacher is Dr. Joan Clinefelter."

Alpha Phi Foundation was the first Greek group to name an international Professor of the Year. Each winner received a \$1,000 honorarium; his or her university scholarship fund received \$1,000. The Alpha Phi chapter and nominating sponsor each were awarded \$250.

Representatives from the National Panhellenic Conference's (NPC) 26 member groups "Celebrated 100 Years of Leadership, Values and Friendship" at the Conference's centennial celebration and interim session Oct. 10-12, 2002, in Oak Brook, Ill.

The opening session brought centennial congratulations from President George W. Bush and proclamations from 27 governors. President Bush's letter read: "Since its establishment in 1902, the NPC has enriched the lives of thousands of women by emphasizing education, leadership, health, safety and many other important issues ... I applaud the NPC for your dedication to maintaining standards for academic and social excellence. Your efforts to promote friendship, service and good citizenship reflect the compassionate spirit of America."

The centennial celebration, chaired by Beth Saul (Alpha Epsilon Phi), featured a special historical exhibit where each member group displayed items. In addition to contributing several pieces of memorabilia, Alpha Phi volunteers compiled a unique

centennial scrapbook featuring congratulatory letters from each NPC group, various universities and interfraternal organizations.

A centennial banquet featured Northwestern University sorority members who reenacted the first NPC meeting with period costumes and songs. Alpha Phi's own **Molly Skjei**, Beta chapter president, was one of the actresses.

Foundation President Jean Scott (Pi Beta Phi) reported the NPC Foundation reached its centennial fund goal of \$750,000.

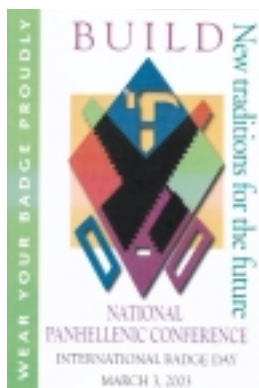
Delegates, inter/national presidents, executive directors and editors from each group had full agendas for their respective meet-

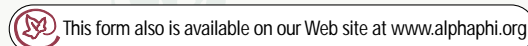
