 - attending the University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie Mellon University, Duquesne University, or Robert Morris University
 - OR -----
 - attending a college or university outside of the Pittsburgh area while maintaining a permanent residence in Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Washington, or Westmoreland County
